NHILL SKATE PARK CONSULTATION

Following a community meeting held in early April 2018, Hindmarsh Shire Council extends an invitation to potential users and other interested residents of the proposed new Nhill Skate Park to a consultation to determine its final design.

The consultation will be held on Monday 25 June 2018 from 4.00pm in the Council Chambers, Hindmarsh Shire Council offices, 92 Nelson Street, Nhill.

Hindmarsh Shire Council Mayor, Cr Ron Ismay said “Following the official openings of the new skate parks at Dimboola and Rainbow, Council is now focusing on finalising the design for the new Nhill skate park before going out for tender.”

Cr Ismay added, “We encourage potential users, interested parents and residents to attend the consultation on Monday 25 June as it will provide an excellent opportunity have input into the final design of the skate park.”

Hindmarsh Shire Council received funding of \$100,000 from the Victorian Government’s 2018/2019 Community Sports Infrastructure Program – Minor Facilities for the new Nhill Skate Park.

“At this stage Council is intending to call for tenders in the near future to provide detailed design and construction of the new skate park as this will potentially enable construction to begin as soon as practical in the new financial year.” Cr Ismay said.

The community consultation on June 25 will be based around the conceptual design of the skate park and any suggested minor changes to the design will be discussed.
