### **Special 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Grease celebrations at the Nhill Cinema!**

Hindmarsh Shire looks forward to hosting a step back in time for a night of 50's fun and entertainment as the Nhill Memorial Community Centre (NMCC) auditorium is transformed into a 50's diner. For one night only, on Friday 21 September 2018, community members will be able to enjoy a retro experience at the NMCC 50's diner followed by the special screening of the cult hit 'Grease' in a Sing-Along special as we celebrate the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the release of the film.

Hindmarsh Shire Council Mayor Ron Ismay said "Community members will have the opportunity to book in for one of the two dinner services on offer either at 5:30pm-6:30pm or 6:30pm-7:30pm. The diner dinner and movie deal includes the cost of dinner and the movie. Tickets are \$20.00 for a child/concession card holder, \$25.00 for adults and \$85.00 for families (1 adult and up to 4 children or 2 adults and up to 3 children). Diner dinner deal prices include 1 drink (Milkshake, Spider or Soft Drink), main meal (Hot Dog or Slider (chicken or beef) with Chips) and Dessert (Ice-Cream Sundae). There are limited spaces available for the diner dinner and movie deal therefore those interested are encouraged to book and pay to secure their place as it is anticipated available places will sell out quickly!" The Hindmarsh Shire Youth Council will be cooking and serving meals, along with providing good, old-fashioned customer service.

Mayor Ismay added "Special ticket prices have also been made available for those who only wish to attend the movie screening. Ticket prices for the movie are \$5.00 for a child/concession, \$10.00 for adults and \$25.00 for families (1 adult and up to 4 children or 2 adults and up to 3 children), with the movie scheduled to begin at 7:30pm. Snacks, and beverages will be available from the box office before and during the screening".

"For those enjoying a diner style dinner there will be a jukebox and classic games that can be

enjoyed during the dinner service times. This is an event you won't want to miss out on!" concluded Mayor Ismay.
