You can do this via the Services Victoria app or with a printed Vaccination Certificate and photo ID.

Children under 16, or those with an approved medical exemption, will still be able to access services.

To assist our community who are unable to access library services in person, click and collect services are available along with e-books, e-audiobooks and e-magazines. Telephone your local Hindmarsh Shire Libraries branch to organise click and collect.

At this stage, Council's Customer Service Centre in Nhill does not require customers to be double vaccinated. COUNCIL SUPPORTS NHILL & DISTRICT HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Hindmarsh Shire Council has decided to take on the role of Committee of Management for the old Lowan Shire Hall. This follows concerns from the Nhill and District Historical Society over the future of the building.

Council was approached by the Nhill and District Historical Society following a meeting held with a representative of DEWLP. The Society were concerned about the future of their building, with DEWLP indicating they do not have any funds to maintain the undertake maintenance works on the building.

The building at 104-106 MacPherson Street Nhill was built in 1888 and was first occupied by the Lowan Shire Council following an official opening in early May 1888. Following the relocation of the Lowan Shire to the current Council office site at 92 Nelson Street in the 1960's the building has been home to the Nhill and District Historical Society.

Council will now work with DELWP to become the Committee of Management on the parcel, which could take up to 18 months to be finalised.

RAINBOW LIBRARY LANDSCAPING

The next stage of this project will see the development of a concept design for a pathway through to The Oasis Community Hub, which will wind its way through existing and new shrubs and trees. The new Library garden and extended pathway are set to provide a link between Federal St and The Oasis.



WIMMERA RIVER DISCOVERY TRAIL UPDATE

In 2019 Hindmarsh Shire Council received funding from State and Federal Governments to implement Dimboola to Lake Hindmarsh section of the Wimmera River Discovery Trail. Total funding for this stage is \$1.2 million, with \$600,000 from the Federal Government's Building Better Regions Fund being matched by \$400,000 from the Victorian State Government and \$200,000 from Hindmarsh Shire Council.

The project is to deliver a 62km cycling and walking trail along the Wimmera River corridor between Dimboola and Lake Hindmarsh. The project includes:

Dimboola visitor node at the rear of the library leading track users to the Nine Creeks trails and onto the Wimmera River Discovery Trail

- Jeparit visitor node at the 'swimming hole' picnic area near the Caravan Park and Tennis Courts
- Directional signage formalisation of existing trails along the river corridor and, where necessary installing new sections of trail.
- Pedestrian bridge across Wimmera River at Jeparit

You can phone our friendly customer service team and provide them with a property address (and assessment number), a brief description of what you are hoping to do, and as much relevant detail as you have available. Please include your phone number and email (if you have one) for Council to get back to

There are also online forms available.

The "Request for Written Planning Advice" form is for those that are serious about the proposal they have for a particular property. This form has a number of questions and a current copy of Title is required so Council can consider any restrictions that may apply to the property. This form attracts a fee; however, a written response will be provided.

For those with a more general enquiry, the "Developing in Hindmarsh" form can be used. A specific address must be provided and advice will be of a general nature only as without a copy of Title, there may be restrictions affecting the property that Council is unaware of. Generally, a verbal response, rather than written, will be provided.

The information provided by you may determine how long it takes for Council to respond. Responses may take between 48 hours to a week or so and complex enquiries may take a little longer to investigate.
