Accessing Council Services

In line with Victorian Government requirements, community members need to show proof of double vaccination to access Council's community facilities.

Children under 18, or those with an approved medical exemption, will still be able to access services.

At this stage, Council's Customer Service Centre in Nhill does not require customers to be double vaccinated. Visitor Information Centre Volunteers

The Hindmarsh Visitor Information Centre, located at Goldsworthy Park in Nhill, offers a great service for travellers visiting or passing through the area. Ideally located in the centre of town on the Western Highway it provides an opportunity to not only provide local information, but importantly can create awareness to the many other great attractions we have in all our towns and places not on the highway, playing a pivotal role in promoting the Shire and wider region to those travelling through from the major cities.

The centre is managed by Council but run day to day by a devoted group of 25 to 30 volunteers. These passionate volunteers keep the visitor centre open 7 days a between 10:30am and 3:30pm, including most public holidays. They provide brochures and tourism information across the region and neighbouring regions, and importantly provide visitors with information on local services. They also give a 'face to the town' and give a friendly human element, something that many visitors seek as part of their attraction to rural areas.

Council values the work of volunteers like our visitor centre volunteers and all community members who volunteer across our Shire!

Creating the new website has allowed Council to make it more userfriendly, easier to navigate and to include features that our previous website didn't allow for. The update means that both current and prospective residents as well as tourists and visitors will easily be able to access the information and services that they need.

It features a more user friendly home page, an events listing page, updated information and new content, improved search functions, a new structure and an integrated Visit Hindmarsh area.

Albacutya Bridge Construction

The construction of the new Albacutya Bridge is nearing completion, with works on the road approaches due to begin soon. Barrier installation also needs to be completed and works are on schedule to be completed around April 2022.



The construction concrete crew have commenced works renewing the old kerb and channel between Hindmarsh Street and Tullyvea Street.



Antwerp - Woorak Road Reconstruction

Works have commenced upgrading a 1.8km section of the road, extending the eastern end of the sealed section. Works are expected to take approximately 5-6 more weeks.



Works are close to complete on a small renewal of a section of the road west of Netherby. Sealing is scheduled shortly, with final preparations currently underway


Nhill Lake Water Supply Update ····

Council are pleased to advise members of the public that another positive meeting was held today with GWM Water to continue discussions with regards to a long term solution for water supply at Nhill Lake. Options have been identified with further testing to be carried out by GWM Water to determine if the solutions are suitable for long term water supply. Council will continue to provide updates as we work through a solution.

How Can You Help?

Excess rainwater is designed to discharge into the stormwater collection channels which then ends up in the lake. Council encourages residents to keep their drains and gutters clear from debris and rubbish, including their vehicle crossover pipes so the water will flow through the drainage system and into the Nhill Lake.
