Nhill Tennis Club Room Update



The new Nhill Tennis Club room continues to progress with contractors pouring the concrete slab in tricky, damp conditions last week.

The new Club Room, which is being built by local builder Leyonhjelm Building Services will give the Nhill Tennis Club a new home after their old Club Room was demolished several years ago after damage incurred in a wind storm made it unsafe.

Council are managing construction of the new facility with funding for the project coming from the Federal Government's Local Roads & Community Infrastructure program and Hindmarsh Shire Council.

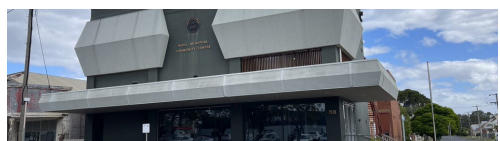

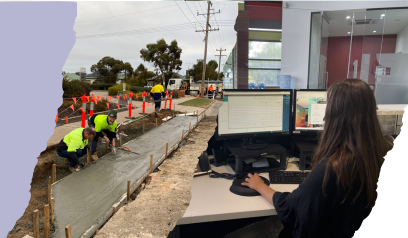
FREE Public Transport for Seniors Card Holders
