- **3.** Watch around Water Please supervise children closely according to our Watch Around Water Policy.
 - **a.** Children under 10 years old: must be accompanied into the centre by a responsible parent or guardian and must be constantly and actively supervised. The parent or guardian must be positioned to have a clear view of the child with no physical or structural barriers between them and the child/children.
 - **b.** Children under five years old: must be accompanied into the centre by a responsible parent or guardian and must be constantly and actively supervised during recreational play within arm's reach.
 - **c.** Children over 10 years old: parents must use their knowledge of the child's swimming ability and general development to determine the level of accompaniment required.
 - **d.** Children under the age of ten years will not be admitted without an appropriate parent/guardian.
 - **e.** We may remove your child from the water if we consider that you are not complying with these requirements or the child is at risk in the water.
