ROADS FUNDING UPDATE

Did you know that the Hindmarsh Shire Council road network is approximately **3,025km in length?** Because of this, Council heavily relies on funding opportunities to maintain and upgrade many of its roads.

Council has applied for funding for the following roads and are still awaiting the outcome:

- Dimboola Minyip Rd upgrade \$1.052 million
- Lorquon Netherby Road \$1.07 million
- Woorak Ni Ni Lorguon Road \$1.559 Million

If successful, the works on these roads would commence in the next financial year following the grant agreement being fully executed.
