

## NEW ANIMAL REGISTRATION APPLICATION

All dogs and cats three months of age or older must be registered. The owner of a dog or cat who fails to register their animal may be liable for an on-the-spot fine for each unregistered animal. All animals being registered **MUST** be microchipped. Council is unable to accept registration unless animal is microchipped.

A completed application and all relevant associated documents are required to be returned to any Hindmarsh Shire Council Customer Service Centre for processing, at which time payments for registration of the animal/s are to be made.

#### **Important Information**

Microchipping	All animals must be microchipped prior to registration, unless previously registered with the Hindmarsh Shire
Multiple Animals	Only 2 dogs and / or 2 cats may be kept at any urban residence without a Permit. Residents must apply for a permit to keep more than the prescribed number of animals
Working Dogs	Only dogs kept specifically for the purposes of working or protecting livestock are eligible to be registered as a working dog. Eligible breeds include Koolie, Kelpie, Border Collie, Maremma and Blue or Red Heelers.
State Government Levy:	The registration fee includes a State Government Levy, which is primarily used to fund responsible pet ownership education programs.
Restricted Dog Breeds:	Pitbull Terrier or American Pitbull Terrier, Fila Brasileiro, Japanese Tosa or Perro De Presa Canario
